

## HOME EVACUATION PLAN



Use the grid below to draw a simple floor plan of your home, marking the doors and windows. Label the sleeping areas. Draw arrows marking two ways out of each room, especially sleeping areas. Post and share the plan with each child or young adult at the time of placement, and practice the evacuation plan at least every six months. A certified family must include in their written comprehensive home evacuation plan a provision for the safe exit of a child or young adult who is not capable of understanding or participating in the evacuation plan.



<b>Evacuation Plan</b> : Write your chosen outside meeting place, the persons responsible for ensuring the children are evacuated, and any special considerations for infants, disabled individuals, and or the environment. Use extra sheets for multi-level residences if needed.
